



## Canada Word of Faith Class Descriptions

*The following first-year and second-year classes are offered at the Canada Word of Faith Bible Training Centre.*

### A SERVANT'S HEART

Serving in the ministry is a key to success. However, many ministers have become so overwhelmed in their desire to serve, that they have become worn out. It is important to know to when to say "yes" and when to say "no". It is equally important to learn to say "yes" to some people and "no" to others. Your servant's heart is determined by your grace and place in the Body of Christ.

### ADVANCED COUNSELLING

Advanced Counselling is a follow up of its parent class "Competent to Counsel" and deals with specific counselling matters, such as marital and family counselling, conflict management, substance abuse counseling, emotional and mental health counselling. The student will receive real life opportunities to become involved a counselling sessions for experience.

### APPLICATION OF FAITH

*James 2:17 So also faith, if it is unaccompanied by obedience, has no life in it—so long as it stands alone. In order for faith to work, it must be accompanied by corresponding actions.*

In "the application of faith" students will learn how the place of actions: if actions are before faith, they are called works. If actions are a result of faith, they are called corresponding actions or obedience.

### BASICS OF FAITH

In order to benefit from faith, it is required that the student knows what faith is, how it works, where it is located and how to effectively put it to work for you from day to day.

The class "Foundations of Faith" will take the use of faith out of the realm of vagueness and smokescreens into the light where you can test whether you are in the faith or in something that looks like faith.

*2 Corinthians 13:5 Examine and test and evaluate your own selves to see whether you are holding to your faith and showing the proper fruits of it. Test and prove yourselves <not Christ>.*

### BIBLE ECONOMICS

Bible Economics is a practical class in which biblical money management is the key issue. The class is based on Luke 16:11 If therefore ye have not been faithful in the unrighteous mammon, who will commit to your trust the true riches?

Students are encouraged to aim for the true riches, such as the souls of men, by being faithful managers of what has been given into their trust.

### BLOOD COVENANT

The class "Blood Covenant" deals with numerous covenants that were made in the Bible and its significance to the plan of Redemption. The student will come to appreciate the manner and method in which God brought about His plan for the human race through infallible covenants. Without the shedding of blood there is no remission of sin, according to Hebrews 9:22 And almost all things are by the law purged with blood; and without shedding of blood is no remission.

### BOOK OF REVELATION

The book of Revelation is a must-read book in order to eliminate fear of the future for the believer. It is a book that reveals the past, present and future of the plan of God for the church, the nation of Israel as well as the nations in prophecy.

### CALLING AND SEPARATION

"Many are called but few are chosen", Every minister will spend a season of life working on their stewardship, fears and faithfulness. When faced with fears or an opportunity to compromise only the strong, word based, faith filled ministers will rise to the top. This class will deal with what it takes to reach a place where the Holy Ghost separates them for the work wherewith they are called. Students will receive tremendous opportunity at Canada Word of Faith Bible Training Centre to overcome fear and learn to make good decisions in stewardship.

## **CHILDREN'S MINISTRY**

In the class "Children's Ministry" students will learn practical aspects of training children in the nurture and admonishing of the Lord, based on Proverbs 22:6 Train up a child in the way he should go: and when he is old, he will not depart from it. An emphasis will be placed on teaching methods, teaching topics and setting up the classroom.

## **COMMUNICATION**

Ministry involves the art of communication. This class will give the student the ability to create meaningful content of a particular topic and surround it with supporting scriptures, sound bytes, multimedia and other communication ingredients, to make the message relevant for the audience. Communication includes homiletics, or the study of the analysis, classification, preparation, composition and delivery of sermons.

## **COMPETENT TO COUNSEL**

Based on Romans 15:14 Personally I am satisfied about you, my brethren, that you yourselves are rich in goodness, amply filled with all <spiritual> knowledge and competent to admonish and counsel and instruct one another also.

In "Competent to Counsel" students will learn to draw from the Word and Spirit of God to empower others to live stress-free and in victory.

## **DEVELOPING A MINISTRY OF PRAYER**

Prayer is one of the foundation block for successful Christian living and a MUST for effective ministry. More than a ritual, a Ministry of Prayer gives the minister a lifestyle of praying that will affect his community, region and nation.

This class furnishes students the different types of prayer, the different rules to praying and the ability to put into practice what has been taught, while watching it come to pass.

Ephesians 6:18 Praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, and watching thereunto with all perseverance and supplication for all saints.

## **EXCELLENCE IN MINISTRY**

Ministry is only effective when the natural and the supernatural, when talent and grace, and when character and anointing become coupled together.

Knowing that your anointing will take you places where your character may not allow you to stay, there is a call going out for believers to live a set apart lifestyle.

Students become aware that they are to live for Glory and Character, based on 2 Peter 1:3 According as his divine power hath given unto us all things that pertain unto life and godliness, through the knowledge of him that hath called us to glory and virtue [or: character].

## **FAITH AND CONFESSION**

One of the main methods that faith is released is through confession. In "Faith and Confession" you will learn the different types of confession that are used in the Bible and which confession accompanies faith in order to bring about true Bible results. This topic is based on Mark 11:23 "For assuredly, I say to you, whoever says to this mountain, 'Be removed and be cast into the sea,' and does not doubt in his heart, but believes that those things he says will be done, he will have whatever he says.

## **FAITH AND LOVE**

Faith works by love, according to Galatians 5:6 For in Jesus Christ neither circumcision availeth any thing, nor uncircumcision; but faith which worketh by love.

In this class "Faith and Love" the student will come to appreciate the importance of walking in love at all times and at all costs in order to activate faith.

## **FAITH AND PATIENCE**

Another component of faith is called "patience" or the ability to endure and remain consistent during difficult times.

While faith helps you get started, it is patience that will cause you to be ready for the long run, as displayed in Hebrews 6:12 In order that you may not grow disinterested and become <spiritual> sluggards, but imitators, behaving as do those who through faith (by their leaning of the entire personality on God in Christ in absolute trust and confidence in His power, wisdom, and goodness) and by practice of patient endurance and waiting are <now> inheriting the promises.

## **FORCE OF RIGHTEOUSNESS**

Of all the gifts that have been imparted to the believer through the New Birth, there is none as powerful as the Force of Righteousness. Romans 5:17 For if because of one man's trespass (lapse, offense) death reigned through that one, much more surely will those who receive <God's> overflowing grace (unmerited favour) and the free gift of righteousness <putting them into right standing with Himself> reign as kings in life through the one Man Jesus Christ (the Messiah, the Anointed One).

Once understood, the student will learn all the benefits that are attached to the force of righteousness or "the position of being right with God".

## **GIFTS OF THE HOLY SPIRIT**

While the Apostle Paul emphasizes that we should not be ignorant of the Gifts of the Spirit, many have grown calloused to the supernatural in Christianity, while others are actually afraid of it.

As a student of the Word and Spirit of Faith, it is of utmost important to know what the Gifts of Spirit are, how they function and what benefit they bring to the Body of Christ and the world.

*1 Corinthians 12:1 Now concerning spiritual [gifts], brethren, I would not have you ignorant.*

### **HEALING IN THE PLAN OF REDEMPTION**

Is healing a fringe benefit of the Gospel? Is healing according to the unknown Sovereign will of God? In “Healing in the plan of Redemption” students will come to appreciate and an understanding that healing is connected to the Cross of Calvary, in the same way that the forgiveness of sin is connected to the Cross of Calvary. When the Lord dealt with sin by a one-time sacrifice, He also dealt with every sickness in the book by that selfsame sacrifice.

*1 Peter 2:24 Who his own self bare our sins in his own body on the tree, that we, being dead to sins, should live unto righteousness: by whose stripes ye were healed.*

### **HERMENEUTICS**

*2 Timothy 2:15 Study to shew thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth.*

Every student is required to study and be able to rightly divide the word of truth and deliver a doctrinally sound message that will cause the hearer to become strong in faith. Hermeneutics – or the Art of Bible interpretation - is a class that studies the written text, and everything in the interpretative process, such as presuppositions, pre-understandings, the meaning and progression of language as well as symbolisms.

### **INTRODUCTION TO CREATION SCIENCE**

In an increasing secular society that denies the existence of a Creator and Creation, it is important that we set the (fossil) record straight.

In “Introduction to Creation Science” the student will learn from a Creation Science instructor and a host of evidence for a Creator and Intelligent Design as opposed to a Big Bang.

Man on three dimensions

To understand the Bible and God’s plan of salvation it is vital to understand the three-fold nature of a human being. Man is not just mind and body, but he is spirit, soul and body, according to 1 Thessalonians 5:23 And the very God of peace sanctify you wholly; and [I pray God] your whole spirit and soul and body be preserved blameless unto the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ.

The redemptive work of the Lord takes part in the unseen realm – in the spirit of a man, affecting his mind and his body.

### **MINISTRY GIFTS**

According to Ephesians 4:7-13, Ministry Gifts are trophies of Jesus’ Ascension who deliver grace to believers in the Body of Christ.

In “Ministry Gifts” the students will come to appreciate the types of ministers and ministries made available to the church and their function to help bring spiritual and numerical growth to the Body of Christ.

### **MINISTRY MANAGEMENT**

Ministry Management is an advanced class for students, who are serious about setting up a well structured ministry able to reach and retain the masses, making converts into disciples of the Lord. Great emphasis is placed on team ministry and how to function as a compatible team player.

### **MINISTRY PROJECTS**

In order to add ability to availability numerous ministry projects are added to the class periods. These projects are geared to affirm and strengthen what has been taught in the previous hours or days. Projects range from solving church government issues to unravelling difficult scriptures to setting up a communion service.

### **MISSION PROJECTS**

Students have the opportunity to set up a mission project from ground zero, and may entail the launching of a mission organization, giving aid to existing mission organization, or setting up a mission trip to a part of Canada or a foreign nation.

The Mission Project will put to the test all of the instructions received over a season and will be beneficial in the set up of the project and the delivery of quality ministry.

Mark 16:15 And he said unto them, Go ye into all the world, and preach the gospel to every creature.

### **NEW CREATION REALITIES**

New Creation Realities or “In Christ Realities” is a class that is foundational to your faith. Now that you are born of God, it is crucial that you no longer identify with the old man, who has died, but that you now begin to renew your mind to who you really are – a new creature in Christ, with assets that have been given to you to overcome sin, sickness, Satan and fear.

Students will learn who they are, what they possess, what they can do, and where they are located as a New Creation.

2 Corinthians 5:17 Therefore if any person is <ingrafted> in Christ (the Messiah) he is a new creation (a new creature altogether); the old <previous moral and spiritual condition> has passed away. Behold, the fresh and new has come!

### **NEW TESTAMENT GRACE**

The Word of God indicates that there are numerous types of grace, ranging from grace by which we are saved to ministry grace to grace that strengthens you inwardly.

Canada Word of Faith Bible Training Students will learn the manifold grace of God and the countless workings of them in the believer and in the church.

1 Peter 4:10 As every man hath received the gift, [even so] minister the same one to another, as good stewards of the manifold grace of God.



## **OLD TESTAMENT SURVEY**

Old Testament Survey is a synthetic study (as opposed to a doctrinal study) of the Old Testament, giving students the ability to only able to grasp the big picture or see the whole forest. This overview is necessary to help understand the details of the Scriptures at a later time.

Students will come to appreciate that the Old Testament is the New Testament concealed, while the New Testament is the Old Testament revealed.

## **PASTORAL EPISTLES**

In the Pastoral Epistles, the Apostle Paul not only reveals some important doctrinal truths to Timothy and Titus, but the student of the Word will also receive a glimpse into the heart and ministry of Paul.

Whether you are called to a pastor, an associate or youth pastor, these Pastoral Epistles become your bricks to successful ministry and leadership.

*1 Timothy 4:16 Take heed unto thyself, and unto the doctrine; continue in them: for in doing this thou shalt both save thyself, and them that hear thee.*

## **PRAYER AND PRAISE**

In Prayer and Praise students are expected to skilfully lead a prayer meeting, praise service or time of testimony to bring the correct expression, making the atmosphere conducive to anointed teaching and the flow of the Spirit.

## **PROSPERITY IN THE PLAN OF REDEMPTION**

In the same way that forgiveness and healing are a part of God's plan of redemption, so prosperity also is a product of the cross of Calvary.

2 Corinthians 8:9 For ye know the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, that, though he was rich, yet for your sakes he became poor, that ye through his poverty might be rich.

Students will learn that prosperity is not a luxury, but a part of the Gospel, helping them to be debt free from the world system and able to go at any time when they are called upon.

## **REGARDING THE RESURRECTION**

The most foundational doctrine of the Bible is the Resurrection of the Lord, which gives us hope of eternal life and the ability to walk by faith.

In "Regarding the Resurrection" students will be instructed in detail regarding the resurrection of Jesus and its surrounding events, as well as the resurrection of the church, which culminates in the rapture of the church at the end of the church age. Other resurrections will also be taught in detail as part of Eschatology, or the doctrine of Last Things.

## **RESULTS OF THE RECREATED HUMAN SPIRIT**

Formerly called "Fruit of the spirit" this class reveals how that you – as a New Creation – have been created to produce fruit – or to get results.

In John 15:1-7, the Lord Jesus gives a lesson in how to go from having no results to getting much fruit, or getting many results. *John 15:5 I am the vine, ye [are] the branches: He that abideth in me, and I in him, the same bringeth forth much fruit: for without me ye can do nothing. {without me: or, severed from me}*

This class is a part of "New Creation Realities" and deals with the recreated spirit of Man being the engine of new ingenuity.

## **SANCTIFICATION IN THE PLAN OF REDEMPTION**

1 Corinthians 1:30 But of him are ye in Christ Jesus, who of God is made unto us wisdom, and righteousness, and sanctification, and redemption.

Besides forgiveness and healing, the plan of redemption also offers a way to live a sanctified – or set apart life. Just like there are general tools to do general jobs, there are dedicated tools to do specific jobs. In "Sanctification in the plan of Redemption" students will become knowledgeable of living a dedicated lifestyle for the Lord and its benefits.

## **SPIRITUAL AUTHORITY**

Just like there are levels of natural authority, there are also levels and degrees of spiritual authority that we must recognize. The more you understand spiritual authority and its effect, the greater your level of faith will be to operate in this world that we live in. The Roman Centurion impressed Jesus with his level of faith. He operated at this level of faith, because he understood authority and saw it operate in the Lord.

Matthew 8:10 When Jesus heard [it], he marvelled, and said to them that followed, Verily I say unto you, I have not found so great faith, no, not in Israel.

## **TEACHING METHODS**

In the class "Teaching Methods" students will become familiar with proven methods of teaching that will work in any size classroom or sanctuary as well as on the streets and one-on-one settings. It is vital to make our message – a message of life and victory – relevant to the audience we are attempting to reach. Proverbs 16:24 Pleasant words [are as] an honeycomb, sweet to the soul, and health to the bones.

## **THE SECOND MAN**

It is important to recognize and occupy your place in the body of Christ – the local Church. Whether you are on the A-team or on the B-team, whether you are called to start churches or paint the walls, there are simply no unimportant members in the local church.

It takes as much grace and commitment to be "the Second Man" as it does to be the Pastor of a church. This class "The Second Man" deals with the blessing and the struggles to be exactly that person "The Second Man".



## **WHAT JESUS SAID ABOUT THE END TIMES**

What Jesus said about the End Times gives any student of the Word a good foundation of understanding End Times or Eschatology. The eager student will learn that Jesus addresses the Nation of Israel in His teachings on End Times, in contrast to Paul, whose teachings are about the End Time for the church. It should come as no surprise that the Lord's reference point is the Second Coming, while Paul's reference point is the Rapture of the Church.

Matthew 24:30 And then shall appear the sign of the Son of man in heaven: and then shall all the tribes of the earth mourn, and they shall see the Son of man coming in the clouds of heaven with power and great glory.

## **WISDOM IN THE PLAN OF REDEMPTION**

More than wealth or fame, it is vital for a believer to find wisdom – the wisdom of God. According to the Scriptures, it is not difficult to find wisdom, for she is shouting aloud in the streets, according to Proverbs 1:20 Wisdom crieth without; she uttereth her voice in the streets.

The Wisdom of God comes to by revelation knowledge – a type of knowledge that is independent and unrelated to sense knowledge and is found in Christ.

In this class the observant student will come to know how to tap into the Wisdom of God by understanding how revelation knowledge comes.

## **YOUTH MINISTRY**

Proverbs 20:29 The glory of young men [is] their strength: and the beauty of old men [is] the gray head.

Youth Ministry is a class in which students will become familiar with the ways and manner to reach young people with the Gospel of the Lord Jesus Christ. While our message stays the same, the vehicle by which we deliver the message may vary depending on the needs of the audience we seek to reach.

An emphasis will be placed on teaching methods, teaching topics and setting up the classroom.
