INTRODUCTION

Now that you have finished your first year at Canada Word of Faith Bible Training Centre, you may qualify for the Second Year Internship Program.

While the first-year program is topic driven, the second year program is project driven and gives you hands-on experience in the ministry. In fact, the Second Year Internship Program, will yield six months of quality ministry experience.

The Second Year Internship Program is designed in such a way that you can find your way into a place of part-time or full-time ministry, depending on the position that you are applying for.

The Second Year Program will add "Ability to your Availability", making you a skilled labourer, disciple and servant of the Lord Jesus Christ, bases on Matthew 22:14 For many are called, but few are chosen.

ADDING ABILITY TO YOUR AVAILABILITY

HOW IT WORKS

As a second year student you will function as an Intern and become part of a team with whom you will accomplish weekly projects, monthly projects and other ministry related tasks. For every two hours of instruction, there is one hour of practical implementations for you and your team.



Your team will receive a project made up of objectives, goals, guidelines and a budget to accomplish your task within a certain time frame.

At the end of the project, your team will be evaluated on how effective you have been in reaching your goal(s) and - as a team member - you will be evaluated on how you helped your team succeed.

ACQUIRING SKILLS AS A MINISTRY APPRENTICE

DEVELOPING SKILLS

Much time will be spent on developing communication skills through homiletical and hermeneutical classes ensuring sound doctrine explained in a systematic fashion.

Communication skills also include the use of well organized multimedia presentations to capture the attention of the hearer and immerse them into the topic under discussion.

Other ministry skills that will be developed, include team ministry skills, organizational skills and people skills.



PROJECTS

Projects include the launching of a church, setting up an evangelistic meeting, organizing an overseas mission trip, creating web sites, video promos and a ministry logo, as well as setting up concerts and ministry fund-raising events.

Students will also have opportunity to become involved with Central Alberta churches on weekends as opportunities arise.

The idea is that you will work yourself into a position with the church that you work with.

MINISTRY OPPORTUNITIES

Not only will you be involved in projects, but you will have opportunity to become familiar with ministry to people through the Second Year Apprenticeship program.

While you are setting up your events and projects as a team, you will be given the opportunity to minister the Word and flow in the Spirit in those meetings and services you have created.

This will be a great time to familiarize yourself with the gifts of the Spirit and the grace that has been given you to function with an anointing.



QUALIFICATIONS FOR SECOND YEAR INTERNSHIP PROGRAM

In order to qualify for the Second Year Apprenticeship Program you must meet the following criteria:

1. You must be a Graduate of the Canada Word of Faith Bible Training Centre's First Year Program or
2. You must be a Graduate of the First Year Correspondence Video Bible School or equivalent, or
3. You must be licensed or ordained with Canada Word of Faith Ministries or equivalent.
4. You must be a Team Player and able to adapt to a group setting

COST OF THE SECOND YEAR INTERNSHIP PROGRAM

The Cost of the Second Year Program is \$2000.00 per person and covers tuition, books, and class outlines. Cheques are to be made out to Canada Word of Faith Bible Training Centre.
